Your research addresses an important issue in the field, and the methodology employed is robust. I found the paper well-structured and the analysis comprehensive. However, there are some significant areas that require attention, and I will provide detailed feedback on these points in my review. I believe that with some revisions, your paper has the potential to make a valuable contribution to the existing literature. Here are some prominent shortcomings in this research paper which need your consideration:

- 1. The abstract and introduction do not clearly define the specific objectives or research questions of the study. While it mentions examining the effects of E-learning training programs, it does not provide a concise statement of what the study aims to achieve.
- 2. The introduction mentions the importance of human resources and training but fails to establish a compelling rationale for why the study of E-learning training programs in Indonesian financial institutions is important. The "dearth of research" is mentioned but without specific evidence or context.
- 3. The literature review is not comprehensive, lacking a thorough discussion of existing research on the topic. It is important to provide a detailed overview of previous studies, findings, and gaps in the literature to justify the need for the current research.
- 4. The paper states that data was collected from employees of various financial institutions in Indonesia, but it does not discuss how the sample was selected or if it is truly representative of the broader population. The absence of information about the sampling method raises

- concerns about the generalizability of the findings.
- 5. While the paper discusses practical implications, it lacks specific recommendations for organizations or policymakers. Providing actionable guidance based on the findings is essential for the paper to have a real-world impact.

- 2. The introduction mentions hypotheses, but these are not explicitly stated in a clear, concise format. Research questions and hypotheses should be presented clearly to guide the study. The introduction briefly mentions the Indonesian financial system, but it lacks in-depth context about the specific challenges or unique features of this context that make the study relevant.
- 3. The paper mentions the use of a Likert scale but does not provide any information on how the questions were developed or validated. It is crucial to discuss how the questionnaire was designed and tested for reliability and validity.
- 4. The paper mentions mediation and moderation hypotheses but doesn't provide sufficient detail on the statistical methods or models used to test these hypotheses. Readers need a clear explanation of how these analyses were conducted and the results.
- 5. The paper seems to make broad claims about the positive impact of E-learning programs on various outcomes.
